AFT SUES FORMER PD

According to courthouse sources the Association of Free Traders has filed a civil action for *1 million against their former Master Trader, Horst Treyder. Lord Treyder is the current General Secretary of the WCE, but the AFT document clearly show that the matter is between the AFT and Horst Treyder, individually, and does not involve the WCE directly.

The AFT is attempting to enforce its profile provision that makes leaving the AFT a matter for a general referendum. According to the AFT suit, when Lord Treyder left the AFT and returned to the Inner Empire he failed to obtain permission from the AFT.

**IMPERIALS REPORT
SUCCESS AGAINST RIP**

(194.44) At a press conference held aboard the ISP Dreadnought Pommern, flagship of the ISP 3rd Battle Squadron, RAdm. Meyer,

announced the fall of RIP colony Slave Driver (1864). Showing footage of the battle, he explained how rather than fight for the doomed pirate base, the Imperial assault GP landed outside the colony, while the fleet subjected the already crippled pirate base to another ferocious bombardment. After the battle, the Imperial GP attacked the colony. 2 RIP ships were found hiding there, both War Galleys.

After the briefing, the press was permitted to view the shattered remains of the colony. ISP shuttles landed reporters at what was left of the starport. Upon exiting the shuttles, we observed that all that was left of the pirate base was numerous collapsed buildings, burned bodies, and smashed equipment everywhere. ISP ground force officers reported that no enemy resistance was encountered at the colony, due to the second bombardment which delivered another 30,000 mu of damage to the pirate's ground defenses, obliterated what was left of the space defenses, and delivered another 37,400 damage to the colony proper. All that was seen to be left of the colony was nothing more than a hole in the ground. Lt. Col. Sielke, commander of the attacking Imperial unit (1/66 AR), explained that Slave Driver would be left as this hole in the ground, as a reminder to all pirates. When asked about the 2 pirate ships, the Imperial officer explained that their engine section would be blown, and the hulks left as further testimony of the battle. The RIP shipyards here would be destroyed, and the hulks confiscated to further the Imperial offensive against the pirates. As the press shuttle left New Boston, additional Imperial assault units appeared to be landing, but the PAO officer aboard the shuttle had no comments on this.

IMPERIALS ANNOUNCE BIG GAINS AGAINST FLAGRITZ

(194.46) At a press conference held at IMP Friday, one time home of the Krieger clan, Imperial public affairs officers announced an unprovoked attack by a Flagritz ship upon an ISP Dreadnought. FGZ Scout Blind Luck, apparently entered orbit and initiated battle with the ISP Schmelzoffen, commanded by Lt Arn Krieger. EEM colony Valka, once a large Imperial naval base and still governed by General Eli Krieger, joined the battle. The Flagritz vessel was utterly destroyed, with no damage taken by either the dreadnought or the colony. Reliable sources indicate that the Krieger clan is pleased that this junior Krieger has gotten his first kill.

PD von Ludendorf was unavailable for comment, however IMP Public Affairs indicated that he was attempting to resolve the problem. When questioned why the IMP had waited so long to release this news, IMP sources indicated that a leader must think of the good of his affiliation first, and put vengeance aside. In response to this, a reporter from the Friday Times-Herald asked if the IMP would then be embarking on a war of genocide of the Flagritz race, this being one of several provocative incidents. The PAO responded that the option was one of many being considered, but that further details couldn't be discussed, however he reiterated that the duty of the ISP PD is to uphold and maintain the peace of the Periphery.... that war was merely a tool used to enforce the peace, but that other options were also being considered.

When asked by a reporter from the Gaspre Morning News about SSL colony Neverhere being attacked and captured by an FGZ ground force, the PAO confirmed this and added that the SSL had very poorly defended their colony, and that the colony was captured by a tiny FGZ GP.... so small that a single IMP Armor Battalion would wipe it out; the whole incident was very suspicious. When asked if it was true that the ISP had received a blackmail letter from the FGZ threatening the lives of the 100,000 colonists at the colony, the PAO confirmed this and added that the ISP was attempting to resolve the situation without any loss of life to the civilians.

(194.47) At a press conference held at ISP Jax, Star Admiral von Ludendorf announced the following: An ITS freighter passing through Applecore observed a destabilization of the Applecore sun. The fluctuations in the magnetic field of the sun matched those of the Canally suns just before they went nova. It is believed that Applecore is about to explode. All sentient beings are advised to evacuate Applecore immediately. Adm. Lanart has a distinguished career with the ISS dating back to 181. This latest achievement is just another feather in her cap.

Detail from ISS handouts on the discovery are that it requires 6 Jump engines to make the jump, and the hull limit is 33 hulls. An unnamed ITS ship has also made the jump and the ISS reports that it's hull shift arrived intact.

QUMAN ANNOUNCE NEW SHIP

(29 Nov 1994) The Quman Information Ministry released the following communiqué about the Quman's new freighter class, the Cargo Master:

This ship is a 12-210-72. Base speeds up to 1.4, even for you no shift humans. Forget the old MERCHANTMAN. Look at the CARGO MASTER. It holds twice as much and hey it is even faster. After over 3 years of research, it is available as select QSN shipyards near you.

Currently, we are delivering CARGO MASTERS at the homeworld in Drell. And other locations are being considered.

If you have an deals, we should talk. We'll take stellars. We'll take items. We'll take tech. Anything is negotiable.

If you want them, we have them. Please order early as we expect demand to be high and you don't want to be at the bottom of the waiting list.

It is the general policy to release Cargo Masters to all allies at normal prices. The Cargo Master is in fact an unique ship design that is twice as effective as the Merchantman. Unlike other affiliations, we do not hog our technology and therefore claim it is more valuable. We understand you are spending real world money and we are glad to aid you in your efforts to solve this ship vs colony problem.

But, if you decide that you refuse to release items that we could use, understand we can do the same thing. We have not raised the price on the Cargo Master, even though we spent 3 years to research this design. All we ask is that affiliations be willing to release similar restricted tech. So offers that include exotics will be considered first. Stellars and normal items are useful, but in reality the Cargo Master is like the Baseships to the FGZ or the Cargo Carrier to the SAM races or Cyberwarriors to the PFM. The only difference is that we have chosen not to restrict the availability of it unduly. So if you have an offer and want to overprice the worth of an item just because you can produce it, please remember that the QSN are the only affiliation that can produce the Cargo Master.

In a related item the new Ataman announced the promotion of NARD' ZARD 'ZHOK to the position of TH FGZ WarLord. At the behest of the TH WarLord, the QSN are now FGZ posted.

WCE NEWS

To all WCE members: This announcement does not affect you. Your ships hulls come from a different place, and are not available for building non-WCE ships.

The WCE news agency, Pravda, announced the successor to the post of Secretary of War. After much deliberation and consideration, the Secretariat chose Sir Arthur Curry to succeed previous War Secretary Brezhnev. Sir Arthur brings many, many years of experience with him to the WCE Central Command, ranging from covert activities to major space and ground battles.
